STANDING RULES OF THE CWGA

MEMBERSHIP & PROGRAMS

I. Club Membership

Club Membership dues shall be \$50.00 annually. Clubs will be expected to give their course for a competition no less than every four years. Each club will select one CWGA representative who will maintain contact with the Reps Coordinator.

If a member club's course changes significantly in yardage or layout, the club's CWGA representative shall notify the CWGA President.

II. New Individual Membership

Any female who meets the following criteria may apply for membership to CWGA:

- An active golf member of a CWGA member club.
- Eligible to participate in golfing activities at her club without payment of additional green fees.
- Has an active handicap index at her member club.
- Has a handicap index of 25.0 or lower.

Application Procedure:

Go to www.cwga.org and click "Join Us" for instructions and guidelines.

New member applications are accepted from **January 1st to October 1st**.

III. Rules of Individual Membership

A. Active Membership:

- Annual dues shall be \$70.00 which includes a \$15.00 donation to the Priscilla Maxwell Endicott CWGA Scholarship Fund.
- Dues shall be paid prior to registration for any event and must be paid by July 1st to be eligible for the Past Presidents' Cup Team matches.
- Once established and properly maintained annually, a member's handicap index may rise above the initial requirements for membership (25.0 index).

B. Interim Membership: A member in good standing who no longer meets the requirements of membership due to extenuating circumstances, may retain her membership for one year, subject to Board approval. Requests for an interim membership must be submitted to the Treasurer/Membership Chair and shall include the reason for the request. Playing privileges and dues are that of a regular member.

C. Leaves of Absence: Requests for a leave of absence must be submitted to the Treasurer/Membership Chair, shall include the reason for the request, and are subject to approval by the Executive Committee. Dues are that of a regular member but playing privileges are suspended during the leave.

IV. Junior Girls' Program

The CWGA Junior events are open to all girls who are Connecticut residents and have not started college. This program is funded by CWGA and is supplemented by individual club and member donations.

V. The Priscilla Maxwell Endicott/CWGA Scholarship Fund

The Priscilla Maxwell Endicott/CWGA Scholarship Fund was established in 1977 with an endowment by Priscilla Maxwell Endicott. This fund provides scholarships to junior female undergraduates for a maximum of four years and is awarded regardless of club affiliation. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of participation in golf programs, academic performance, and financial need.

CWGA is committed to the support and success of the Scholarship Fund and encourages its members to pledge their support.

COMPETITIONS

I. ENTRIES

Online Tournament Registration:

- Registration for all tournaments is done online. To begin, go to **cwga.org** and select “Tournaments”. From there, you will be linked to “Golf Genius”, a third-party system endorsed by the USGA to manage golf tournaments. Log-in to Golf Genius with your own email address and Golf Genius password to register for all tournaments.
- CWGA reserves the right to limit the field. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. If an event is oversubscribed, a waiting list will be established.
- A waiting list may also be established **before** the closing in order to ensure evenly paired groups (e.g.foursomes).
- Pairings will be determined by the Tournament Committee for the Championships, the Medallion, Presidents’ Cup, and all Draw events.
- Substitutions or changes to registration can be made online before the registration closes. After the closing date, players must contact the One-Day Coordinator or the Tournament Chair for changes.
- Withdrawals made prior to the **registration closing date** are subject to a \$5 cancellation fee or other non-refundable fee, if so stated. Withdrawals after the closing date will result in forfeiture of ALL entry fees. The only exception is if the tournament is cancelled, in which case, a full refund will be issued.

II. TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES

- Complete tournament procedures are provided for each event on its tournament information/portal page.
- The Tournament Committee will determine if a sufficient number of players are registered for the event. If an insufficient number of players are registered, then the tournament may be cancelled.

A. TOURNAMENT RULES

- USGA and Local Rules as posted by the Tournament Committee shall govern all play.
- All complaints, disputes or interpretations of golf rules should be referred to the CSGA Tournament Official.
- Carts are mandatory at CWGA events.
- The use of a multi-functional device (e.g. cell phone) for distance measuring purposes is permitted, but should be limited to ONLY this function during the round, unless used for emergency purposes.
- Tie-breaks will be determined using the recommendation from USGA unless otherwise specified for an individual tournament.
- Tournament results are unofficial until the tournament is closed by the CSGA Tournament Official and Tournament Committee and prizes are awarded.
- Non-compliance with any tournament procedures or rules may result in disqualification from the tournament.

B. PACE OF PLAY POLICY

- A player must play without undue delay.
- Players are responsible for knowing their position on the golf course relative to the groups around them. Players and their group should strive to stay with the group in front of them and play “Ready Golf”.
- The Tournament Official is authorized to manage slow play and may alert players/groups if they are out of position.

C. PRIZES

- Prizes will be awarded to approximately one-third of the tournament field.
- Non-trophy prizes are awarded immediately following the tournament.
- Prizes are in the form of pro-shop credit issued for redemption at the host club.

D. POSTING OF TOURNAMENT SCORES

- All scores at CWGA One-Day and stroke play Championships will be posted for the players by the Tournament Official/Committee.
- Scores from Best Ball events will be posted by the Tournament Official. Therefore, if a player does not “hole out”, she should record either her *most likely score* or the maximum allowable score (net-double bogey) and include an X on the scorecard.

TROPHY TOURNAMENTS

- If the field is oversubscribed, one-half of the field will be filled by entrants having the lowest handicap indexes, and the remaining will be selected by draw. Exceptions will be determined by the Tournament Committee.
- Defaulting or withdrawing will only be allowed at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Anyone defaulting or withdrawing without permission of the Committee may be subject to future sanctions, which may include being ineligible to play in the event the following year.

CWGA CHAMPIONSHIP

- The Championship is a single elimination match play event, played on a gross basis, within two divisions. **Maximum handicap index is 25.** Tournament details are defined each year by the Tournament Committee. A stroke play qualifier may be held at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

CWGA SENIORS' CHAMPIONSHIP

- CWGA Seniors' Championship is a 36-hole stroke play event open to CWGA members 55 or more years of age as of the first day of the tournament. Maximum handicap index is 28.4.
- The GROSS winner will be awarded the Mrs. Raymond S. Patton, Jr. Trophy to be held for one year.

CWGA LEGENDS' CHAMPIONSHIP

- CWGA Legends' Championship is an 18-hole stroke play event open to CWGA members who are 70 or more years of age as of the day of the tournament. Competitors must play to a maximum handicap of 30.4.
- The GROSS winner will be awarded the Louise B. Curtis Trophy to be held for one year.

CWGA JUNIORS' CHAMPIONSHIP

- CWGA Juniors' Championship is a 36-hole stroke play event for female golfers. To be eligible, players must be CT residents, 18 years of age or **younger** and have not started college. No club affiliation is necessary.
- Junior female golfers aged 13 to 18 who are members of the Connecticut PGA Junior Golf Association earn points toward the Junior Player of the Year Program based on their results in CWGA Junior Championship.

SPECIAL TOURNAMENTS

PRESIDENTS' CUP TOURNAMENT

- This is a one-day event played in a Best-Ball of 2 format at 95% handicap.
- Partners may be from different member clubs.
- Presidents' Cup winners shall be the team with the overall lowest best-ball net score.
- The names of the winning team members shall be added to the Presidents' Cup Trophy. The winners will be awarded the Presidents' Cup Trophy to be held for one year.

MEDALLION TOURNAMENT

- This is a one-day stroke play partner event open to two players from the same member club who will play as a team in an aggregate format combining net and gross stableford scores. A member club is not limited to the number of teams it can send.
- The gross stableford score of the gross player will be added to the net stableford score of the net player for the aggregate team score.
- The names of the winning team members shall be added to the Medallion Plaque.
- The selection criteria of the club's gross player and the net player is at the discretion of each club.
- Winners will be awarded the Medallion Plaque to be held for one year.

TEAM COMPETITIONS

CONNECTICUT-RHODE ISLAND TEAM MATCH

- This is a one-day match play team event open to CWGA members with a handicap index of 14.4 or less and who have posted a minimum of five scores in the current year. 18 players will be selected from each state to play, 8 players and 1 alternate for each gross and net division.
- Team members will compete in a four-ball match (best ball of two) as well a singles match for the Connecticut Rhode Island Cup, All play is without strokes.

CWGA-SNEWGA TEAM MATCH

- This is a one-day match play team event open to 20 CWGA members in handicap index groupings **up** to 21.9 and who have posted a minimum of 10 Connecticut scores in the current year.
- The four-ball matches (best ball of two) will be played with strokes.

ENDICOTT CUP & TRI-STATE COMPETITION

- The Endicott Cup and Tri-State Competition is a 3-day event including players from Connecticut, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island.
- CWGA applicants must have a 17.0 or lower handicap index and have posted a minimum of ten Connecticut scores in the current year.
- Days 1 and 2 are a stroke play competition for the Endicott Cup Trophy.
- Day 3 is a three-ball match play contest among the states.
- Players are named to their respective teams based on their low gross and low net scores of the previous two days. Each state also names a gross and a net player alternate whose scores count toward the team total unless an alternate is needed as a substitute in an emergency.
- The Tri-State Bowl will be awarded to the winner of the gross category. The Mrs. Charles F. Eaton Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the net category.

PAST PRESIDENTS' CUP INTERCLUB MATCHES

- Teams wishing to compete in Cup Team Matches must file the application as set forth by the Cup Coordinator. No club may enter more than two teams.
- The application must provide three possible dates for one team and four for two teams. One of the possible dates offered will be scheduled for a club to host matches. Tuesdays and Fridays are preferable days for play.
- Cup Team Matches are open to any member club. Detailed rules and regulations for these matches will be distributed to all participating CWGA clubs.
- To be eligible for team competition, a player must have posted at least 5 scores in the current calendar year prior to playing in matches.
- All new member applications must be completed and accepted by August 15th of the current year.
- All matches will be played with strokes. However, in any match, the maximum course handicap allowed will be 25.
- Host clubs expect players to stay for lunch and all team members are strongly encouraged to do so.
- Players shall enter scores into golf genius at the completion of their round.

GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

CWGA members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that fosters the best interests and traditions of the game of golf, CWGA and the host club. Players are expected to:

- Stay for lunch.
- Tip the locker room and bag attendants appropriately where allowed.
- Maintain the integrity of the venue. Wear proper golf attire, replace divots, rake bunkers, and drive carts as directed.
- Full tournament policies and procedures are made available for each event in the online registration portal.

Any conduct on the part of a member which is considered detrimental to the best interest of the game, the welfare of the CWGA, or is in contradiction to the objectives, by-laws, rules, or other policies of the CWGA or the host club, may subject the member to disciplinary action.

NOTES

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE CONNECTICUT WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

Article I - Name

The name of this organization shall be "The Connecticut Women's Golf Association" herein referred to as the CWGA or the Association.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of this non-profit Association is to provide competitive golfing opportunities for its members, to promote understanding of the rules of golf, and to encourage female junior golfers statewide.

Article III - Membership

Section 1. Club membership in the CWGA shall be limited to private golf or semi-private country clubs in the state of Connecticut.

Each Member Club shall sign an agreement with CWGA. Each Member Club is apprised of the course obligation via the annual dues billing statement.

Section 2. Any club meeting the requirements of Section 1 may request membership in CWGA and may be admitted by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Committee.

Section 3. The adoption of Section 1 of this Article shall not affect the membership of any club now a member in good standing except if a Member Club changes its Private/Semi-private classification to Public. In that case it may have to forfeit its membership on request of a two-thirds vote of the Executive Committee.

Section 4.

- A. A female golfer at a CWGA member club may become an individual member if she:
- Has full golfing privileges without payment of additional greens fees.
 - Meets the handicap index requirements as determined by the Executive Committee.
 - Has a handicap index that is registered at her member club.
- B. A member in good standing who no longer meets the requirements of membership due to extenuating circumstances, may retain her membership for 1 year, subject to approval of the Ex-

ecutive Committee. Playing privileges and dues are that of a regular member.

- C. A leave of absence may be granted at the discretion of the Executive Committee. Dues are that of a regular member but playing privileges are suspended during the leave.
- D. A non-playing membership may be requested by any individual having reached 75 years of age and 25 years of membership. Dues for non-playing members are waived.
- E. All Past Presidents may retain lifetime memberships, shall be exempt from annual dues, and shall be eligible to compete in all CWGA events.

Article IV - Dues

Section 1. The annual dues for a Member Club shall be determined by the Executive Committee and approved by the Governing Board.

Section 2. The annual dues for individual membership shall be determined by the Executive Committee and approved by the Governing Board.

Section 3. Any club or individual member whose annual dues are unpaid shall be ineligible to participate in the affairs of the CWGA.

Article V - Officers, Executive Committee, and Governing Board

Section 1. The officers of the CWGA shall be: President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2. The Executive Committee shall be comprised of the officers duly elected by individual members of CWGA at the Annual Meeting held in even numbered years and the immediate Past President. They shall hold office for 2 years or until their successors are chosen. Vacancies in any office shall be filled by a vote of the members of the Executive Committee. Such an appointee shall serve for the remainder of the term. A majority of the members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum. The Executive Committee shall also act as the Finance Committee.

- A. The **President** shall preside at all CWGA and Executive Committee meetings. She shall be an ex-officio member of all committees. She shall serve as a liaison from CWGA to the USGA, the CSGA, SNEWGA, and other like associations and committees, and in general perform all duties incident to her office. The President may designate a member of the Executive Committee to act on her behalf as a liaison from CWGA.

- B. The **First Vice President** shall perform all duties of the President during her absence or inability to act. Under the general direction of the President, she shall oversee all the CWGA communications and administrative functions including, but not limited to the CWGA Newsletter, the CWGA Website, Membership Handbook, the Club Reps Coordinator and the Public Relations Coordinator.
- C. The **Second Vice President** shall perform all duties of the First Vice President during her absence. Under the direction of the President, she shall oversee all the CWGA golf competitions, including but not limited to Major Tournaments, Team Events, Past President's Cup Matches, One-Day Tournaments, Tournament Site Planning, Prizes, Trophies, and Tournament Rules.
- D. The **Secretary** shall keep minutes of Governing Board meetings, Executive Committee meetings, and the Annual Meetings of members. She shall send notices of all meetings. She shall be responsible for records and correspondence of the CWGA. She shall compile the annual reports from committee Chairs and include them with her minutes of the Annual Meeting.
- E. The **Treasurer** shall keep a full account of the money received and dispersed as designated by the Executive Committee. She shall be bonded to the limit deemed necessary by the Executive Committee. The premium for said bond shall be paid by the CWGA. She shall present a written financial report at each Annual Meeting. She shall be Chair of Membership.
- F. The **Immediate Past President** shall serve as Chair of the Nominating Committee. She shall recommend 4 members to serve on the Nominating Committee to the Executive Committee. Those recommended shall be appointed by the Executive Committee no later than March 1st of the election year. The Nominating Committee will recommend a slate of officers to the CWGA Governing Board 6 weeks before the Annual Meeting and to all members of the CWGA 30 days before the Annual Meeting in election years.
- Independent nominations for officers must be made in writing and signed by at least 10 individual members representing at least 5 Member Clubs. These independent nominations must be received by the Secretary at least 15 days before the Annual Meeting. Notice of such independent nominations must be sent to all CWGA members at least 5 days before the Annual Meeting.
- G. The **Executive Committee** has the power to conduct the affairs of the CWGA except as otherwise provided in this Constitution and By-Laws.
- H. In January, the Executive Committee shall arrange for an independent audit of the Treasurer's accounts of the previous year.

- I. The Executive Committee shall be responsible for formulating the financial policies of the CWGA, have general supervision relative to the allocation of the income and expenditures and other fiscal matters of the CWGA, and present the same to the Governing Board upon request for consideration and approval.

Section 3. The CWGA Governing Board includes: the executive committee, chairs of the standing committees and appointed positions as stated in this section.

- A. **Standing Committees:** The President, with the approval of the Executive Committee, shall appoint the Chairs of the following standing committees who shall serve for a term of 2 years beginning at the Annual Meeting held in even numbered years and/or until their successors are appointed.

1. **Major Tournament Committee:** The Major Tournament Committee shall consist of a Tournament Chair who shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board and as many members as the Chair deems necessary. The Committee is responsible for the procurement of courses, planning, and conduct of all major CWGA tournaments, including CWGA Championship, CWGA Seniors', Legends' and Junior Championship (in conjunction with the Junior Chair), and other tournaments designated as major tournaments by the CWGA Governing Board. She shall assist with the Endicott Cup when held in Connecticut. It is the responsibility of the Major Tournament Committee to work with representatives of clubs hosting major tournaments on all details involved with the tournament and with other CWGA Governing Board members and Tournament Officials. The Committee shall coordinate its activities with the Second Vice President.

2. **Past Presidents' Cup Committee:** The Past Presidents' Cup Committee shall consist of a Cup Coordinator who shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board and as many members as the Cup Coordinator deems necessary. The Committee shall be responsible for team cup matches for all member clubs entered in the annual competition. The Committee shall coordinate its activities with the Second Vice President.

3. **Teams Committee:** The Teams Committee shall consist of a Team Captain and additional members the Captain deems necessary. She shall serve on the CWGA Governing Board. The Committee shall be responsible for the selection of the players and all matters related to CWGA team competitions. The Committee shall coordinate its activities with the Second Vice President.

4. **Junior Committee:** The Junior Committee shall consist of a

Chair who shall serve on the CWGA Governing Board and as many members as the Chair deems necessary. The Committee shall be responsible for the conduct of female Junior golf activities and tournaments. She shall coordinate her actions with the Major Tournaments Chair and the One-Day Tournament Coordinators when necessary. The Chair shall serve as a member of the Priscilla Maxwell Endicott Board (PME). The Committee shall coordinate its activities with the Second Vice President.

5. **Website Communications Committee:** The Website Communications Committee shall consist of a Chair and as many members as she deems necessary. The Chair shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board. The Committee shall be responsible for overseeing the website, and shall coordinate activities with the First Vice President.

6. **PME/Scholarship Committee:** The PME/Scholarship Committee shall consist of a Chair who shall serve on the CWGA Governing Board. The Chair shall be elected by the Priscilla Maxwell Endicott (PME) Board and such other members as the Chair deems necessary. The Committee shall be responsible for the awarding of scholarships.

7. **Past Presidents' Committee:** The Past Presidents' Committee shall consist of all living past presidents of the CWGA. The Committee shall elect a Chair who shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board provided that such chair shall not hold any other position on the CWGA Governing Board. The Committee shall serve as mentors to new members of the CWGA Governing Board, provide advice, preserve the history of CWGA, and conduct studies at the request of the Executive Committee, and undertake other such activities as the Executive Committee may request. The Committee shall coordinate its activities with the President. In the event that the Committee Chairman cannot attend a Board Meeting, she shall send a delegate in her place who shall have a vote on any matter before the Governing Board.

B. **Appointed Positions:** The President, with the approval of the Executive Committee shall appoint the following:

1. **Tournament Site Planner:** The Tournament Site Planner shall serve on the CWGA Governing Board. She shall be responsible for procuring sites and pricing for the CWGA one-day golf competitions. The planner shall coordinate her activities with the President and Second Vice President.
2. **One-Day Tournament Coordinator:** The One-Day Tournament Coordinator shall serve on the CWGA Governing Board. She shall be responsible for managing online regis-

trations, and all aspects of the one-day tournament events. She may appoint assistants as she deems necessary. The Coordinator shall organize her activities with the President and Second Vice President.

3. **Reps Coordinator:** The Reps Coordinator shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board. She shall be responsible for overseeing the activities of club representatives each year. The Reps Coordinator shall coordinate her activities with the First Vice President
 4. **Newsletter Editor:** The Newsletter Editor shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board. She shall be responsible for informing the membership of updates and changes about the organization by producing newsletters and other electronic communications deemed necessary by the Governing Board. She shall coordinate her activities with the First Vice President.
 5. **Membership Handbook Editor:** The Membership Handbook Editor shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board. She shall be responsible for producing the annual CWGA membership handbook.
 6. **Public Relations Coordinator:** The Public Relations Coordinator shall serve as a member of the CWGA Governing Board. She shall provide the media with information prior to, during and after all our major competitions and special events. She is also responsible for the collection and preservation of pertinent newspaper articles and photographs. She shall coordinate her activities with Past Presidents' Committee for archival purposes.
- C. **Other Committees:** The President may appoint other committees or positions as necessary. Ad hoc committees or appointments require approval from the Executive Committee. Such committees have no voting privileges on the CWGA Governing Board. Consult Article VIII of this Constitution and By-Laws to implement a permanent committee or position to the Governing Board.
- D. **Terms of Office:** The term of office of all chairs and appointed positions shall be co-terminous with the term of the office of the President.
- E. **Vacancies:** Vacancies in any of the positions created under this Section 3 of this Article V shall be filled by the President with the approval of the Executive Committee. Such an appointee shall serve for the remainder of the term.
- F. **Limitation of Voting Power:** In the event any committee chairman cannot attend a Board meeting, she may cast her vote by

proxy. In no case shall any chair or committee member cast more than one vote.

Article VI - Meetings

Section 1. The Annual Meeting of the CWGA shall take place in the Fall at such a time and place as the Executive Committee shall designate.

Section 2. A **Special Meeting** of the CWGA may be called by the President, by a majority of the Executive Committee, or at the request of at least 10 members representing at least 5 member clubs. Notice thereof shall state the purpose of the meeting. Other business shall be not be conducted.

Section 3. No meeting shall be held without 10 days notice to all individual members of time and place of said meeting.

Section 4. The Secretary shall declare a **quorum** when 10% of individual members representing at least 7 Member Clubs are present at the Annual Meeting or any special meeting. No voting by proxy shall be allowed.

Section 5. At any meeting of the CWGA, any member communicating through any means of communication that allows all members participating in the meeting to simultaneously hear each other during the meeting, including but not limited to video or telephone conferencing, shall be deemed to be present in person at the meeting for all purposes, including quorum and voting.

Article VII - Obligations and Discipline

Section 1. Club membership in the CWGA shall bind each Member Club to provide its course for tournament dates agreeable to both the Member Club and the CWGA.

Section 2. Each Member Club and individual member must agree to uphold and abide by all the provisions of this Constitution and By-Laws and to accept and enforce all decisions of the Executive Committee.

Section 2A. Any Member Club or individual member failing in the obligations as set forth may be suspended or expelled by a majority of the Executive Committee. They shall have the right to appeal for rein-

statement at a special meeting of the CWGA Executive Committee called for such purpose.

Section 3. Upon dissolution, the assets of the CWGA shall be allocated to the Priscilla Maxwell Endicott/CWGA Scholarship Fund.

Article VIII - Amendments

This Constitution and By-Laws may be amended or repealed at any meeting of the CWGA by a two-thirds vote of those individual members present. Voting may occur provided written notice of each proposed amendment shall have been sent electronically to each member 30 days before the meeting.

Article IX - Order of Business

The following Order of Business shall be observed unless otherwise ordered by the Executive Committee:

1. Roll Call
2. Reading of Minutes of Previous Meeting
3. Secretary's Report
4. Treasurer's Report
5. Report of Committees
6. Election of the Executive Committee
7. General Business
8. Adjournment

Article X - Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order Revised shall govern CWGA in all matters of procedure except where they are inconsistent with the Constitution or By-Laws.
